You will need:

- Cloth
- Paintbrushes
- Resene testpots of Resene Get Reddy and Resene Suzie Q
- Resene Waterborne Smooth Surface Sealer
- Sandpaper
- Small tin



Step one

Carefully sand the tin with sandpaper – this will help the paint to stick. Wipe clean with a cloth.



Step two

Paint the tin with one coat of Resene Waterborne Smooth Surface Sealer and allow to dry.



Step three

Paint the tin with two coats of Resene Suzie Q, allowing two hours for each coat to dry.



Step four

Paint the words 'secret stuff' on the lid of the tin with Resene Get Reddy and allow to dry. How cool is that?



Top tip:

Make sure you don't get any paint or sealer around the join where the lid fits on - otherwise you may not be able to open your tin!



Here's another idea:

This flower vase was made from an old Resene paint pot and decorated with Resene Alabaster, Resene Fizz and Resene Poppy.
