



#### DESIGN IN COLOUR

**Blocks of colour define function and fun in this house on a dune in Eastbourne.**

In designing a new home for this coastal site, architect James Warren created a paint scheme that clearly articulates the different parts of the house.

Surrounding the whole site and creating sheltered courtyards on all sides, a tall concrete-block wall is finished in Rockcote Masonry Render Quarter Stack. Behind the wall, timber cladding is tinted in the dark, recessive tones of Resene Lumbersider Low Sheen Double Cod Grey and Resene Lumbersider Low Sheen Half Baltic Sea. Interior walls are painted with Resene Manyana. Above the ceiling height, timber light catchers are stained with Resene Waterborne Woodsman Natural. For a pop of colour? Port holes are picked out in cheerful Resene Green Spring.
