What is a carcinogen?

A carcinogen is a substance that causes cancer [or believed to cause cancer].

Carcinogen

CLASS 1: Known or presumed human carcinogens.

The placing of a chemical in class 1 is done on the basis of epidemiological and\or animal data.

- Class 1A: KNOWN to have carcinogenic potential for humans.
- Class 1B: PRESUMED to have carcinogenic potential for humans.

CLASS 2: Suspected human carcinogens.

The placing of a chemical in class 2 is done on the basis of evidence obtained from human and\or animal studies but which is not sufficiently convincing to place the chemical in class 1.

Identify your solvents/carcinogens *i.e. toluene\xylene*

Wear correct protection for the solvents *i.e. glove up, mask up*

Correct ventilation for your site and work place *i.e. extractor fans*

Remember VOC/s are heavier than air *i.e. extract from ground level*

Be site safe for yourself and other workers

i.e. remember your work mates
