YOU WILL NEED

- 4 litres in a shade of your choice from Resene's Whites & Neutrals chart (we used Resene
- 1-2 litres Resene Lustacryl Semi-Gloss Waterborne Enamel in a blue shade of your choice (we used Eastern Blue). Note: 1 litre allows two coats on a single chair; use 2 litres for a two-seater
- · A selection of paint brushes

Step 1 Arrange your various pieces of furniture in their correct places around the room before deciding which pieces to paint in neutral tones (most of them) and which to paint in the accent shade (one or two).

Step 2 Paint the furniture all over, turning the items upside-down to get full coverage. Allow to dry and repaint.
