

# Make it special

To enliven this kitchen, the designer chose a Resene Metallics and Special Effects paint

**Using contrasting textures is a good way to make different materials stand out in a kitchen.** For this project, owners Andrew and Emma Bull teamed dark American oak cabinets with a glittering gold-coloured glass splashback.

Resene Imperite IF 503, in Resene Bullion from the Resene Metallic & Special Effects range provides a glistening copper gold that offsets the dark cabinets and stainless steel appliances. The metallic finish and glass help to bounce light around the room, and introduce a refined look to the Balinese-influenced design. The gold of Resene Bullion also picks up the tones of the Mousse granite benchtops.

The Resene Metallic & Special Effects collection features a broad range of precious-metal finishes and a kaleidoscope of coloured metallic and subtle pearlescent finishes.

Other products to consider for your kitchen include Resene Fly Deterrent, which discourages flies from sitting on the painted surface.
