

# Little boy blue

Fresh in soft blue and white stripes, this baby's room was painted in Resene colours

**Repainting a room can bring about the most dramatic change, and it's probably the most cost-effective way to renovate.**

To give this baby's room a fresh look, the owners repainted the walls in blue and white stripes using Resene French Pass and Resene Quarter Pearl Lusta. The ceiling was painted in Resene Ceiling Paint, and the high-gloss skirting, windows and doors feature Resene Alabaster.

The crisp lines were achieved with Resene Green Professional masking tapes.

The walls were painted in Resene SpaceCote Low Sheen, a recommended paint type for broadwall areas.
