# FIREWOOD STACKER

*In this easy peasy winter project, Jacob Leaf builds a cinder block wood stand.*



## MATERIALS

**You will need** • 2 x 400mm x 190mm x 190mm cinder blocks  
• 5m X 75mm x 50mm H3.2 radiata  
• **Paint colours** • Resene Keppel  
• Resene Paprika • Resene Aquamarine • Resene Torea Bay (Vroom) • Resene Pizazz (Hi Jinx)  
**COST** \$50, excluding all the Resene paints.

- 1** Cut the timber into 4 X 1200mm pieces. Then sand off any rough edges.
- 2** Prime and paint the timber and the cinder blocks.
- 3** Insert the 4 pieces of timber into the cinder block hollows and rest them at an angle to form a V-shape.
- 4** Stack with wood. ❁
