



Pretty *in* Pink

MARK RAYNER turns an ordinary pot into a work of art.

You will need:

- Terracotta pot
- Resene Quick Dry Acrylic Primer Undercoat
- Resene testpots in Resene Pompadour, Resene Sassy, Resene Cabaret, Resene Shocking
- Resene Multishield+ gloss
- Terracotta sealer
- Masking tape
- Pink cyclamen
- Potting mix



1 COAT the inside of the pot with terracotta sealer and the outside with one coat of Resene Quick Dry Acrylic Primer Undercoat. Allow to dry.



2 APPLY two coats of Resene Pompadour to the outside of the pot, allowing two hours between coats.



3 APPLY eight vertical equidistant strips of masking tape to the side of the pot. Apply a light coat of Resene Pompadour along the edge of the masking tape (this prevents colour bleeding). Allow to dry.



4 PAINT over the unmasked areas with two coats of Resene Sassy. Allow to dry.



5 APPLY another eight strips of masking tape, at equidistance, between the previous eight. Again, lightly paint along the edge of the masking tape with Resene Sassy.



6 PAINT over the unmasked areas with alternating coats of Resene Cabaret and Resene Shocking. Allow to dry and repeat.



7 CAREFULLY remove all 16 strips of masking tape and touch up any imperfections. Dry overnight.



8 APPLY two coats of Resene Multishield+ gloss, allowing each coat to dry thoroughly. Plant up with potting mix and pink cyclamen.
