

Create this gorgeous golden bangle using a fabulous hot pink Resene colour and Resene Art Action Gold Effects.

### You will need:

- Paintbrush
- Resene Art Action glaze (gloss)
- Resene Art Action Gold Effects
- Resene Art Action Quick Dry
- Resene testpot of Resene Mandy
- Wooden bangle (ours came from 'Spotlight')



#### Step one

Paint the bangle with one coat of Resene Quick Dry and allow to dry for two hours.



#### Step two

Paint the bangle with two coats of Resene Mandy, allowing two hours for each coat to dry.



#### Step three

Apply one coat of Resene Art Action Gold Effects to the outside of the bangle and allow two hours to dry.



#### Step four

Paint the bangle with one coat of Resene Art Action Glaze, allowing two hours to dry. How gold-tastic is that?!

#### Top tip:

You can also paint a plastic bangle in the same way – just roughen it up first with sandpaper and use Resene Waterborne Smooth Surface Sealer instead of Resene Quick Dry.



#### Here's another idea:

This cool striped bangle was painted with Resene Gorse and Resene Niagara.
