#### You will need:

- Clean cloth
- Old varnished shelving unit
- Paintbrush
- Resene Lustacryl tinted to Resene Desire and Resene Elvis
- Resene Waterborne Smooth Surface Sealer
- Sandpaper



**Step one**Lightly sand the varnish to provide a 'key'.



**Step two**Wipe off any sanding dust with a clean dry cloth.



Step three
Turn the unit upside
down and paint the
undersides of the shelves
and feet with one coat
of Resene Waterborne
Smooth Surface Sealer.



Step four
Turn the unit the right
way up and paint the
shelf tops and edges
with one coat of Resene
Waterborne Smooth
Surface Sealer. Allow two
hours to dry.



Step five
Turn the unit upside down
and paint the undersides
of the shelves with two
coats of Resene Desire,
allowing two hours for
each coat to dry.



Step six
Paint the feet with two
coats of Resene Elvis,
allowing two hours for
each coat to dry.



Step seven
Turn the unit the right
way up and paint the
upright supports with
two coats of Resene
Elvis, allowing two hours
for each coat to dry.



Step eight
Paint the shelf tops and edges with two coats of Resene Desire, allowing two hours for each coat to dry.

Transform an old shelving unit into a fabulously colourful feature with a little bit of help from Resene.



### To get the look:

Mark painted the background wall with Resene SpaceCote Low Sheen tinted to Resene Onepoto.



#### Other ideas:

Try a hot yellow and red combo using Resene Turbo for the shelves and Resene Get Reddy for the feet and upright supports.
