

Revamp a deck



→ Difficulty level ★easy ★★moderate ★★★challenging

Ways with wood with Mark Rayner - 47

You will need:

- Brush or broom
- Bucket
- Garden hose with clean running water
- Paintbrush

Paint stirrer

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- Resene Moss & Mould Killer
- Resene Timber and Deck Wash
- Resene Woodsman Wood Oil Stain tinted to Resene Warm Kwila
- Turpentine for washing brush

For a waterborne finish use Resene Woodsman Decking Stain.



Step one

Thoroughly sweep the deck to remove and dust and dirt.



Step two

Mix one part Resene Moss & Mould Killer with five parts clean water.



Step three

Apply a generous amount of the diluted solution across the deck and scrub into the grooves using a brush or broom, Leave for 48 hours.



Step four

Mix one part Resene Timber and Deck Wash with three parts water.



To get the look:

Mark painted the background raised bed with Resene Lumbersider tinted to Resene Westwood.

Exterior

Step five

Scrub the diluted solution across the deck, allowing the surface of the timber to remain wet for 10 to 15 minutes.



Thoroughly rinse off the Resene Timber and Deck Wash with clean water. Allow the deck to dry.



Step seven

Carefully stir the Resene Woodsman Wood Oil Stain with a flat stirrer.



Step eight

Apply two coats of Resene Woodsman Wood Oil Stain to the deck, running in the direction of the grain. Allow 24 hours for each coat to dry.



Other ideas:

For a darker finish use Woodsman Resene **Wood Oil Stain tinted** to Resene **English** Walnut.
