# Preparation

- Treatment with Resene Timber and Deck Wash (see Data Sheet D813) is recommended for all substrates to remove dirt, natural stains and enhance the degree of product penetration. Ensure surfaces to be stained are dry, free from dust, dirt and loose material
- If mould is present, treat with Resene Moss & Mould Killer (see Data Sheet D80).
- For repaints of existing penetrating stains remove any gross contamination and loose cellulose fibres.
- All sanding dusts may be harmful and appropriate protection must be worn. In particular dusts from old lead or chromate based paints or old building materials containing asbestos may be injurious to health if inhaled or ingested. Seek expert advice if the presence of these materials is suspected.
- Always colour test first to check your choice of Resene Woodsman Whitewash colour gives the result you want on the actual timber you are staining.
- Consult your Resene ColorShop or Reseller for advice on coating severely weathered surfaces, exotic timbers, nonstandard timbers and exterior doors and windows.

- Where alkaline cleaners (including Resene Moss & Mould Killer) are used in the preparation of the substrate, ensure that any residue is removed by hosing down with clean water. These residues can affect film formation and, subsequently, durability
- Always test the finish you plan to use with a Resene testpot. If you see tannin staining occurring then change to either a standard solventborne Resene Woodsman Wood Oil Stain system (choosing from the colour range available for that product) or a solid colour painted system with an enamel primer, such as Resene Wood Primer (see Data Sheet D40). Tannin staining most commonly occurs with application to flat sawn cedar cladding and will tend to wash out over two to three months of direct weathering.

# **Application**

- Before use and regularly during use, stir well with a wide
- Apply one full coat and allow to dry before applying second
- All faces of the timber should be treated with special attention to end grains
- For new work apply the second coat preferably before one week. Protection begins after full system is applied.
- Will not penetrate through existing coatings or very hard latewood bands. For best results wipe excess Resene • Stains are not acceptable finishes for substrates that will Woodsman Whitewash off with a dry, absorbent, lint-free cloth rubbing along the grain.

# Ouick check

Use on: Timber surfaces.

Gloss level: None. Fully penetrating over bare

**Typical coverage**: (a) Dressed timber:

1st coat, 10-12 square metres per litre, 2nd coat, 12-14 square metres per litre.

(b) Rough sawn timber:

1st coat, 4-6 square metres per litre. 2nd coat, 9-11 square metres per litre.

(c) Badly weathered timber:

1st coat, 3-4 square metres per litre, 2nd coat 5-7 square metres per litre.

**Dry time (minimum)**: 45 minutes. Drying is slowed by low temperatures and high humidity. Do not apply under damp conditions.

Recoat time (minimum): 2 hours.

Primer required: No.

Usual number of coats: Two. Will require maintenance after two to three summers.

**Application method**: Brush or roller.

Thinning and clean up: Do not thin. Clean up with water when wet or mineral turps when dry. **Colour range**: Whitewash and greywash.

Before use: Stir well with a wide flat stirrer and also stir during application.
